Men only, 18 and older, must have ID

31 residential program beds (13 mo. comprehensive program)

31 transient beds, 30-day limit

### **REACH Cold Weather Shelter**

301-733-2371

Adults only, last weekend in October through first weekend in April

Open Sunday 3 pm – 7 am, Monday – Saturday 7 pm – 7 am

42 beds: 30 men, 12 women

When the temperature or wind chill factor is 32 degrees or below and/or there is the presence of snow, up to 6 overflow beds are available.

Has a rapid rehousing (housing first) program for homeless individuals

### **Community Action Council**

Transitional housing/family shelter including a rapid rehousing (housing first) for families

Multiple units owned + works with landlords for rapid rehousing

### **Salvation Army**

- 28 beds
- Shelter for women & children; no males over the age of 12
- Females 17 & over are seen as individual and must stay there by themselves.
- Must actively look for employment daily
- 2 women share each room
- 30 day maximum stay
- Help with clothing, food, and laundry and refer to other agency
- 30-day Washington County residency requirement

13 women's beds

13 men's beds

Intake: give name & contact info and shelter will call them and set up appt when space is available. During interview must sign agreement to terms:

- Must do chores
- Must participate in job search, resume writing, and self-marketing (assistance offered in those areas)

Computers available. There is a curfew.
