This fund awards multiple scholarships annually ranging from \$1,500 to \$7,000 to racially minoritized students (preference to African American students) who reside in Washington County, Md., and are pursuing a degree in education or a related field. Scholarships are eligible for renewal until degree is obtained or maximum award reached. The goal of the scholarship is to remove financial barriers, offer support, and increase the number of racially diverse teachers in Washington County Public Schools.

Who is this for?

- High school graduates just accepted into college
- Para-professionals or associate's degree holders seeking a teaching certification.
- Anyone seeking a degree in education or a related field (i.e. teaching, school counseling, etc.)

In 2022 and 2023 a total of 9 scholarships were awarded, with 5 potentially eligible for renewal in 2024. Diverse applicants and funding are sought for the 2024-25 program year.
