JOB DESCRIPTION

POSITION OVERVIEW

The Associate Minister curates a community of youth and adults who have fun sharing church. The Associate Minister resources mission ministries of our congregation. Annually, the Associate Minister develops a ministry out of their passion for serving Jesus and the community. The Associate Minister will share worship, pastoral and teaching opportunities with the Senior Minister on a scheduled frequency.

FAMILY / YOUTH (6TH- 12TH GRADE) MINISTRY (45%):

- Curate a community of youth and their families who have fun sharing church with their peers while engaging in service, study, "intentional community building", and recreation.
- Commitment to providing pastoral care for this community of families and youth.
- Demonstrate a "priesthood of all believers" approach to developing ownership by volunteers in this ministry.

COMMUNITY CARE (30%):

- Curate opportunities for service to our community, local and beyond.
- Provide staff resourcing to the mission ministries of our congregation.
- Develop lay leadership in mission ministries to expand capacity.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES (15%):

- In the absence of the Senior Minister, function as the head of staff.
- Periodically preach and regularly lead worship as assigned by the Senior Minister.
- Tenthusiastically support and promote the mission, values, and goals of First Christian Church within the congregation and wider community.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Senior Minister.

SPECIAL FOCUS MINISTRY (10%)

- Each year, implement a ministry experience from associate minister's passion.
- To be under umbrella of existing ministry and in partnership with a volunteer team.
- Requires approval of the senior minister.
